RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL TRADE AGREEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The governor shall not enter into any

3	(b)	For purposes of this Act, "state approval" occurs

 10 the minority party, who shall be appointed by the
 11 president of the senate.
- The committee shall select a chairperson from its membership.
- 14 The joint legislative committee to consider 15 international trade agreements shall meet to consider and 16 approve or disapprove proposed international trade agreements at 17 any time when the legislature is not in session. A majority of 18 all the members shall constitute a quorum to do business. 19 a quorum is in attendance, the concurrence of a majority of the 20 members in attendance shall be required to approve a proposed 21 international trade agreement.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
