## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTAL CARE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In 2006, the legislature appropriated funds to
- 2 the department of human services to restore specific preventive
- 3 and restorative dental services for eligible persons twenty-one
- 4 years of age or older under the State's medicaid and QUEST
- 5 programs. Previously, dental coverage for eligible adults was
- 6 limited to dental emergencies. According to a recent department
- 7 of health report, each eligible adult can receive specific
- 8 preventive and restorative services, including dentures,
- 9 equivalent to \$500. However, this does not include coverage for
- 10 endodontic, root canals, crowns, elective procedures, or
- 11 periodontal surgery. Also, partial and full dentures generally
- 12 cost more than \$500.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to expand coverage under
- 14 medicaid and QUEST to include comprehensive dental care coverage
- 15 for eligible persons twenty-one years of age or older and to
- 16 appropriate funds to provide the additional coverage.

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         SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
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    and to read as follows:

    provide comprehensive coverage to medicaid and QUEST recipients

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         The department shall administer this benefit in a manner

    that meets federal requirements that are a condition of the
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    receipt of federal funds by the State.
         For purposes of this section "comprehensive coverage" means

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         SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
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    revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of $30,000,000, or so
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    much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and
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    the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
    year 2008-2009, to expand coverage under medicaid and QUEST to
