A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATURE, THE AUDITOR, THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, AND THE OMBUDSMAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$7,694,360 or so much 2 thereof as may be necessary for defraying any and all session 3 4 and nonsession expenses of the Senate up to and including 5 June 30, 2008, including the 2007 regular session, Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session expenses and 6 the expenses of any committee or committees established during 7 the interim between the 2007 and 2008 regular sessions. 8 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$11,670,163 or so much thereof as may be necessary for defraying any and all 11 12 session and nonsession expenses of the House of Representatives 13 up to and including June 30, 2008, including the 2007 regular 14 session, Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, and pre-session expenses and the expenses of any committee or 15

16 committees established during the interim between the 2007 and

17 2008 regular sessions. HB HMS 2007-1333

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1 SECTION 3. Payment of expenses of the Senate during the 2 interim between the 2007 and 2008 regular sessions shall be made only with the approval of the President of the Senate, and 3 payment of expenses of the House of Representatives during the 4 interim between the 2007 and 2008 regular sessions shall be made 5 6 only with the approval of the Speaker of the House of 7 Representatives. SECTION 4. Before January 16, 2008, the Senate and the 8 9 House of Representatives shall each have their accounts audited, 10 and a full report of the respective audits shall be presented to 11 the Senate and to the House of Representatives convening on 12 January 16, 2008. SECTION 5. Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the 13 14 expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad on official business of the legislature shall be \$130 a day as 15 authorized by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the 16 House of Representatives, respectively. 17 18 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,646,810 or so much thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor for the 20 following expenses: 21

5	revolving fund the sum of \$5,600,438 or so much thereof as may

12	thereof as may be necessary to the legislative reference bureau				
13	for defraying the expenses of the legislative reference bureau				
14	during fiscal year 2007-2008, including equipment relating to				
15	computer systems programming and operations.				
16	SECTION 10. There is appropriated out of the general				
17	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$971,500 or so much				
18	thereof as may be necessary to the office of the ombudsman for				
19	defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year 2007-				
20	2008.				

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thereof as may be necessary for defraying the expenses of the 1 2 legislative information system: 3 (1)\$900,000 to the Senate; and \$900,000 to the House of Representatives. 4 (2)This appropriation shall be used to pay for hardware, software, 5 consultant, installation, material, supply, and other related 6 7 costs associated with the legislative information system that have been or will be incurred. 8 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$175,000 or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary for the legislative broadcast 11 12 program, including the production and distribution of television broadcasts of legislative proceedings. This appropriation shall 13 be expended by the legislature for the purposes of this section. 14 15 SECTION 13. Except for moneys in the audit revolving fund, 16 as of the close of business on June 30, 2008, the unexpended or unencumbered balance of any appropriation made by this Act shall 17

18 lapse into the general fund.

19 SECTION 14. Each section of this Act is declared to be20 severable from the remainder of this Act.

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1 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
