BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 328J-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

16	(b)	Violations of subsection (a), including placement of a
17	cigarette	vending machine in a location other than a bar,

- cabaret, or any establishment for which the minimum age for 1 2 admission is eighteen, are subject to a fine of up to [\$1,000 3 per day for each violation.] \$ for the first offense. Any 4 subsequent offenses at the same location within shall 5 subject the person to a fine of not less than \$ or more 6 than \$. 7 (c) As used in this section: 8 "Cigarette vending machine" means a self-service device that dispenses cigarettes, cigars, tobacco, or any other product 9 10 containing tobacco[-], except a vending machine that dispenses cigarettes, cigars, tobacco, or any other product containing 11 12 tobacco through the operation of a device that requires a 13 salesperson to control the dispensation of the product. 14 "Lunch wagon" means a mobile vehicle designed and constructed to transport food and from which food is sold to the 15 16 general public and includes but is not limited to manapua 17 trucks. 18 "Self-service display" means a display that contains 19 cigarettes and is located in an area openly accessible to 20 customers and from which customers can readily access cigarettes 21 without the assistance of a salesperson. - 3 "Sell" or "sale" means to solicit and receive an order for;
- 4 to have, keep, offer, or expose for sale; to deliver for value
- 5 or in any other manner than purely gratuitously; to peddle; to
- 6 keep with intent to sell; or to traffic in."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2010.
