A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need for 2 educational assistants, particularly certified educational 3 assistants, to work in Hawaii's public school system. Pursuant 4 to the reauthorization of the Individuals with Disabilities 5 Education Act and the requirements set forth in the No Child 6 Left Behind Act, the department of education is mandated to 7 improve the quality of instruction and services to Hawaii's 8 students by providing staff training programs and opportunities. 9 The legislature also finds that the department of education 10 has developed a career ladder program for educational assistants 11 who meet specific job requirements based on training, job performance, and years of experience as an educational 12 13 assistant. The educational assistant career ladder program recognizes training as a means to attain salary advancement. 14 15 The goal of the program is to attract, retain and reward quality

16 and excellence in educational assistants by:

17 (1) Providing opportunities for professional growth;

(3) Providing educational assistants with incentive, salary supplement, and career advancement programs. 4 5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the department of education to implement and fund the career ladder 6 7 program for educational assistants.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the 11 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 12 2008-2009, for the department of education to implement and fund 13 the educational assistant career ladder program.

14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 15 of education for the purposes of this Act.
