BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The legislature finds that there is a need for 2 educational assistants, particularly certified educational 3 assistants, to work in Hawaii's public school system. to the reauthorization of the Individuals with Disabilities 4 Education Act and the requirements set forth in the No Child 5 Left Behind Act, the department of education is mandated to 6 7 improve the quality of instruction and services to Hawaii's 8 students by providing staff training programs and opportunities. 9 The legislature also finds that the department of education 10 has developed a career ladder program for educational assistants 11 who meet specific job requirements based on training, job 12 performance, and years of experience as an educational The educational assistant career ladder program 13 assistant. 14 recognizes training as a means to attain salary advancement. 15 The goal of the program is to attract, retain, and reward 16 quality and excellence in educational assistants by:
