BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§</u> 26	9- Certificate of public good. (a) No public	
5	utility:		
6	(1)	May begin site preparation for or construction of an	
7		electric generation facility or electric transmission	
8		facility within the State that is designed for	
9		immediate or eventual operation at any voltage; or	
10	(2)	May exercise the right of eminent domain in connection	
11		with the site preparation for or construction of any	
12		transmission or generation facility, as described in	
13		paragraph (1),	
14	unless the public utilities commission first finds that the same		
15	will prom	ote the general good of the State and issues a	
16	certifica	te of public good to that effect.	
17	<u>(b)</u>	A certificate of public good shall be issued to the	
18	applicant	if the public utilities commission finds that the	
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1	purchase,	investment, or construction of the proposed electric
2	generatio	n or transmission facility is required to meet the need
3	for prese	nt and future demand for service that could not
4	otherwise	be provided in a more cost-effective manner through
5	energy co	nservation programs and measures and energy efficiency
6	and load	management measures.
7	<u>(c)</u>	For each application for a certificate of public good,
8	the publi	c utilities commission shall:
9	(1)	Hold a public hearing or hearings on the island on
10		which the proposed facility is to be located; provided
11		that notice of the public hearing shall be given in
12		the manner prescribed in section 269-12(c); and
13	(2)	Hold a hearing at a location that it selects.
14	(d)	The public utilities commission may conduct its review
15	of public	good and its review of proposed capital expenditures
16	for proje	cts related to plant replacement, expansion, or
17	moderniza	tion in excess of \$500,000, as set forth in Standards
18	for Elect	ric Utility Service in the State of Hawaii, General
19	Order No.	7, concurrently."

Description:

Requires electric utilities to obtain a certificate of public good from the public utilities commission for the construction of any electric transmission or generation facility, prior to beginning site preparation or exercising the right of eminent domain.
