A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that educating the public 2 about clean energy resources, energy technology, and sustainability issues is critical to our future. The Blue 3 Planet Festival is a public-private partnership that promotes 4 sustainability and clean energy through education, technology, 5 and musical entertainment. 6 7 The Blue Planet Festival will bring world-class 8 entertainers to join local musicians at an event powered 9 entirely by clean energy sources. The two-day event is also 10 expected to attract positive media attention to Hawaii's and the 11 world's energy resources. Other festival-related events 12 include: 13 An energy conference of government, industry, non-(1)14 governmental, and scientific leaders to address local 15 and global energy issues; (2) A technology showcase to display the latest in energy 16

1 (3) An educational component to inform and inspire Hawaii 2 residents, especially students, about the positive 3 impact of, and the crucial need for, clean energy 4 resources and technology. 5 The purpose of this Act is to promote sustainable and clean 6 energy by appropriating funds for the department of business, 7 economic development, and tourism to sponsor an energy 8 conference and participate in the Blue Planet Festival 9 activities to showcase energy technology, promote energy 10 resources education, and address local and global energy issues. 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 for a 13 conference and festival on energy resources, clean energy, 14 15 technology, and sustainability. 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of 17 18 this Act.
