A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF WATER FOR AGRICULTURAL USE ON LANAI.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. A one hundred-acre space on the island of Lanai
- 2 was designated by the department of agriculture as an
- 3 agricultural park to increase the diversity of the island
- 4 economy. While the availability of ample water supply at a
- 5 reasonable cost is essential to the creation of an agriculture
- 6 industry, water on Lanai is provided by a private company that
- 7 has increased its water rates to such a degree that agriculture
- 8 is not economically feasible for any farmer. The creation of an
- 9 agriculture industry necessitates assistance in payment for the
- 10 water. Lanai Water Company, a privately-owned company that
- 11 provides water on Lanai, has offered to match any water subsidy
- 12 provided by the State to pay for the purchase of water by
- 13 farmers on Lanai. The legislature therefore finds it to be in
- 14 the best interests of the state to help create an agriculture
- 15 industry on Lanai by providing assistance to Lanai farmers in
- 16 their purchase of water.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to assist
- 2 Lanai farmers in purchasing water for agricultural use.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 to assist
- 6 Lanai farmers in purchasing water for agricultural use; provided
- 7 that no funds shall be expended unless matched dollar-for-dollar
- 8 by Lanai water company.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
