A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOTER REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 286-111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§286-111 Application for license, provisional license, or instruction permit; fees. (a) Every application for an 4 5 instruction permit, provisional license, or driver's license shall be made upon a form furnished by the examiner of drivers 6 7 and shall be verified by the applicant before a person authorized to administer oaths. The examiner of drivers and 8 9 officers serving under the examiner may administer the oaths without charge. Each application for an instruction permit for 10 a category (1), (2), (3), or (4) license shall be accompanied by 11 a fee to be determined by the council of each county and each 12 application for a provisional license or driver's license shall 13 be accompanied by the fee, unless the applicant has already paid 14 15 the fee upon application for an instruction permit in the same 16 county, in which event no fee shall be charged. An additional fee to be determined by the council of each county shall be 17

charged and collected upon the issuance of a provisional license

- 1 or driver's license. All of the foregoing fees shall become
- 2 county realizations.
- 3 (b) The director of transportation shall establish a fee
- 4 schedule for all commercial driver's licensing examinations.
- 5 The fees collected for a commercial driver's license shall
- 6 become state realizations and deposited in the state highway
- 7 fund. The State shall reimburse the counties all costs for
- 8 administering the commercial driver's licensing program. The
- 9 amount of reimbursement shall be determined by the director of
- 10 transportation.
- 11 (c) Every application shall state the full name, date of
- 12 birth, sex, occupation, social security number if the applicant
- 13 is eligible for a social security number, the residence address
- 14 and business address, if any, of the applicant, and shall
- 15 briefly describe the applicant, and shall state whether the
- 16 applicant has theretofore been licensed as a driver, and, if so,
- 17 when and in what state or country, and whether any such license
- 18 has ever been suspended or revoked, or whether an application
- 19 has ever been refused, and if so, the date of and reason for the
- 20 suspension, revocation, or refusal.
- 21 (d) If the applicant is not eligible to receive a social
- 22 security number, the applicant shall submit, in lieu of
