4	SECTION 2. Section 448-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
5	amended to read as follows:		
6	"§448-11 Investigations and hearings. The board of dental		
7	examiners, or its duly authorized representative, may inquire of		
8	any applicant for examination concerning the applicant's		
9	character, qualifications, or experience and may conduct		
10	investigations and hearings in order to secure further		
11	information concerning the character, qualifications, or		
12	experience of any such applicant[-], including but not limited		
13	to a background check conducted by the board of dental
