RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 2 amonded by adding two new gostions to be appropriately
- 2 amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§150A-A Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service
- 5 **charge.** (a) The department shall prescribe a schedule of
- 6 service fees and charges and collect appropriate service fees or
- 7 charges for invasive species inspection, quarantine, and
- 8 eradication services from any person who imports any article or
- 9 means of conveyance. The department shall establish a schedule
- 10 of service fees and charges to ensure that the service is
- 11 commensurate with the costs of inspection, quarantine, and
- 12 eradication services.
- (b) Any person who imports an article or means of
- 14 conveyance shall pay the service fees or charges to the
- 15 department before the article or means of conveyance is moved
- 16 from a port of entry in the State.

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1	<u>(c)</u>	If a person subject to the service fees or charges
2	under thi	s section fails to pay the service fee or charge when
3	due, the	department shall assess a late payment penalty.
4	(d)	The service fees or charges collected by the
5	departmen	t under this section shall be deposited into the
6	invasive	species inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund.

9	treasury	the invasive species inspection, quarantine, and

21	(b)	The moneys in the invasive species inspection,

- 3 invasive species are detected at ports of entry."
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 150A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by adding three new definitions to be appropriately
- 6 inserted and to read as follows:
- 7 ""Article" means any material or tangible object that could
- 8 harbor an invasive species, including plants, plant products,
- 9 soil, boxes and containers, vehicles, baggage, or packing
- 10 material used in connection with the movement of plants, plant
- 11 products, or animals.
- "Invasive species" means the same as that term is defined
- under section 520A-2.
- 14 "Means of conveyance" means any personal property used for
- 15 or intended for use for the movement of any other personal
- 16 property that could harbor an invasive species."
- 17 SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 18 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 19 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 20 the new sections in this Act.
- 21 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

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1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
