A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WORKS OF ART SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:			
3	"(a) There is created a works of art special fund, into			
4	which shall be transferred one per cent of all state fund			
5	appropriations for capital improvements designated for the			
6	construction cost element; provided that this transfer shall			
7	apply only to capital improvement appropriations that are			
8	designated for the construction [or renovation] of state			
9	buildings. The one per cent transfer requirement shall not			
10	apply to appropriations from the passenger facility charge			
11	special fund established by section 261-5.5.			
12	(b) The works of art special fund shall be used solely for			
13	the following purposes:			
14	(1) Costs related to the acquisition of works of art,			
15	including any consultant or staff services required to			
16	carry out the art in public places and relocatable			
17	works of art programs;

Works of Art Special Fund

Description:

Allows up to 50 percent of funds in the Works of Art Special Fund to be used for capital improvement projects, the purchase of facilities, and the repair and maintenance of facilities dedicated to the arts and culture. Removes capital improvement appropriations that are designated for renovation of state buildings from the works of art special fund's 1 per cent transfer requirement.
