A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X, SECTIONS 2 AND 3 OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION TO CREATE ELECTED DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an 2 amendment to Article X, section 2 and 3, of the Constitution of 3 the State of Hawaii to provide for the creation of at least 4 seven locally elected district school boards and to amend the 5 function and selection of the state board of education. 6 SECTION 2. Article X, section 2, of the Constitution of 7 the State of Hawaii, is amended to read as follows: 8 "[BOARD OF EDUCATION] STATE AND DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARDS 9 Section 2. There shall be a state board of education 10 composed of [members who shall be elected in a nonpartisan 11 manner by qualified voters, as provided by law, from two at-12 large school board districts] one member selected from each 13 district school board. Each district board shall select its 14 representative to the state board by majority vote among the 15 district board members. Each state board member, with the 16 exception of the member from the noncontiguous district, shall 17 have a vote on matters before the state board of education. HB HMIA 49-2007

1	There shall be at least seven district school boards
2	composed of members who shall be elected in a nonpartisan manner
3	by qualified voters, as provided by law, from each of the school
4	board districts. [The first] <u>At least two</u> school board
5	[district] <u>districts</u> shall be comprised of [the] <u>areas of</u>
6	approximately equal populations and inclusive of the Hilo and
7	Kona regions on the island of [Oahu and all other islands not
8	specifically enumerated. The second school board district shall
9	be comprised of the islands of Hawaii, Maui, Lanai, Molokai,
10	Kahoolawe, Kauai and Niihau. Each at large school board district
11	shall be divided into departmental school districts, as may be
12	provided by law. There shall be at least one member residing in
13	each departmental school district.] Hawaii as determined by an
14	apportionment commission as provided for by law. At least one
15	school board district shall be comprised of the islands of
16	Lanai, Molokai, Kahoolawe, and Maui. At least one school board
17	district shall be comprised of the islands of Kauai and Niihau.
18	The Island of Oahu shall have at least three school board
19	districts. The districts shall be determined by an
20	apportionment commission as provided for by law. The Hawaii
21	State Student Council shall select a public high school student
22	to serve as a nonvoting member on the state board of education.

1	Local student councils shall select a public high school student
2	to serve as a nonvoting member on each district school board of

4	SECTION 3. Article X, section 3, of the Constitution of
5	the State of Hawaii, is amended to read as follows:
6	"POWER OF THE [BOARD OF EDUCATION] STATE AND DISTRICT
7	BOARDS OF EDUCATION
8	Section 3. The state board of education shall have the
9	power, as provided by law, to [formulate statewide educational
10	policy and] appoint the state superintendent of education, [as
11	the chief executive officer of the public school system]
12	formulate funding formulae to fund each district board of
13	education, create statewide education standards, and oversee
14	equity and compliance with federal law.
15	District boards of education shall have the power, as
16	provided by law, to formulate district wide educational policies
17	not inconsistent with statewide education standards and effect
18	budget decisions within the district. District boards of
19	education shall have all other powers not specifically delegated
20	to the state board of education."
21	SECTION 4. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
22	be as follows:

1 "Shall the current constitutional provisions on the creation 2 and power of the Board of Education be amended to provide 3 for the creation of at least seven local district school 4 boards elected by the voters of each local school district?" 5 SECTION 5. Constitutional material to be repealed is 6 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is 7 underscored.

8 SECTION 6. This amendment shall take effect upon
9 compliance with Article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
10 the State of Hawaii.
