## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SAFETY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the measures to
2	reduce the number of pedestrian accidents have not been
3	successful. By the end of opening day of the 2007 Hawaii State
4	Legislature, there were already 6 pedestrian deaths.
5	The legislature finds that we need to effect other safety
6	measures to protect our citizens. One option is to keep
7	pedestrians well informed of the dangers of some of these
8	walkways and intersections, and to install safety devices to
9	reduce the danger of these intersections.
10	The purpose of this Act is to fund a study to compile a
11	list of the most dangerous crosswalks in the State, and to
12	retrofit the crosswalks with safety lights.
13	SECTION 2. The department of transportation shall
14	conduct a bi-annual study of the most dangerous crosswalks in
15	the State. In order to determine the most dangerous walkways
16	the Department of Transportation may include:
17	(1) The amount of accidents between moving vehicles

and pedestrians in a given area;

1	(2)	The number of moving violations on a given	
2		stretch of road before and after the crosswalk;	
3	(3)	The number of vehicles that move through an	
4		intersection;	
5	(4)	The number of fatalities at a given intersection;	
6		or	
7	(5)	Any reasonable measure of safety the department,	
8		in its discretion, deems relevant.	
9	The depart	ment may also use similar information compiled by	
10	other entities	to complete the study. The department of	
11	transportation	shall submit this report to the legislature no	
12	more than 20 da	ays before the start of the legislative session.	
13	SECTION 3	. The department of transportation shall install	
14	flashing lights on the most dangerous crosswalks as determined		
15	by the study co	ommissioned by this Act.	
16	SECTION 4	. There is appropriated out of the general	
17	revenues of the	e State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so	
18	much thereof as	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, for	
19	the funding of	the study of dangerous crosswalks and	
20	intersections.		
21	The sum a	opropriated shall be expended by the department of	
22	transportation	for the purposes of this Act.

1	SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general		
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$, or so much		
3	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the		
4	same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
5	2008-2009, for the installation of safety lights at crosswalks		
6	and intersections identified as dangerous by the study mandated		
7	by this Act.		
8	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department		
9	of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
