"Commercial activity" means to engage in any action or to 10 11 attempt to engage in any action for compensation in any form. 12 The action or actions may include, but are not limited to, soliciting, advertising, providing, or attempting to provide, 13 14 guide services, charters, tours, and transportation to and from 15 the location or locations for which such services are provided. "Compensation" means money, barter, trade, credit, and 16 other instruments of value, goods, and other forms of payment. 17
