## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Within sixty days following the final		
2	determination of the specific mass transit corridor and the		
3	locations of the transit stations serving the mass transit		
4	system by the city and county of Honolulu, the department of		
5	land and natural resources and the Hawaii housing finance and		
6	development corporation are directed to identify all public		
7	lands within one-half mile from the transit corridor and within		
8	one mile radius of any transit station that are suitable for		
9	housing development pursuant to chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised		
10	Statutes.		
11	A list of the public lands so identified shall be		
12	transmitted to the governor who, within sixty days of the		
13	receipt of the list and pursuant to section 171-11, Hawaii		
14	Revised Statutes, but without the requirement of the approval of		
15	the board of land and natural resources, shall set aside those		
16	identified public lands to the Hawaii housing finance and		
17	development corporation for the development of housing pursuant		

to chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

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1	SECT	ION 2. Twenty days prior to the convening of the next	
2	regular s	ession of the legislature following final determination	
3	of the mass transit corridor and location of the transfer		
4	stations, but not less than one hundred eighty days following		
5	the setting aside of the public lands pursuant to this Act, the		
6	Hawaii ho	using finance and development corporation shall submit	
7	a report	to the legislature containing but not limited to the	
8	following	:	
9	(1)	A list of the public lands set aside pursuant to this	
10		Act;	
11	(2)	A prioritized list of the public lands so set aside in	
12		accordance with each parcel's suitability, based on	
13		location, topography, and proximity to existing	
14		infrastructure, for housing development pursuant to	
15		chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes;	
16	(3)	A proposed timetable for the development of housing on	
17		the prioritized list of selected parcels; and	
18	(4)	An estimated capital cost for the development of	
19		needed infrastructure and construction of housing	
20		units on the parcels identified pursuant to this Act.	

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

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Report Title:

Public Lands; Affordable Housing

## Description:

Directs department of land and natural resources and Hawaii housing finance corporation to identify public lands within 1/2 mile of the city's transit corridor or within a mile radius of any designated transit station suitable for affordable housing. Requires governor to set aside the identified public lands for the development of housing. Requires report to legislature.
