A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A STUDY ON ENERGY EFFICIENT TRANSPORTATION STRATEGIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds transportation is
- 2 responsible for an inordinate amount of fuel consumption,
- 3 including fuel used in motor vehicles, busses, and jet planes.
- 4 The legislature further finds that reducing the demand for fuel
- 5 in transportation modalities would greatly reduce our dependence
- 6 on oil.
- 7 The Hawaii energy policy forum, a part of the social
- 8 sciences public policy center at the University of Hawaii at
- 9 Manoa, proposes to conduct a study on energy-efficient
- 10 transportation strategies in conjunction with the department of
- 11 business, economic development, and tourism.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for an
- 13 energy-efficient transportation strategies study.
- 14 SECTION 2. (a) The Hawaii energy policy forum at the
- 15 University of Hawaii at Manoa shall conduct a study on energy-
- 16 efficient transportation strategies in conjunction with the
- 17 department of business, economic development, and tourism.

9	(c)	The social sciences public policy center shall engage
10	Hawaii's	business, government, labor, and community leaders and

13	(d)	The department of business, economic development, and
14	tourism shall consult with and otherwise assist the social	
15	sciences	public policy center at the University of Hawaii at
16	Manoa on	the energy-efficient transportation strategies study.
17	(e)	The Hawaii energy policy forum shall submit a report
18	on its fi	indings and recommendations to the legislature not later
19	than twer	nty days prior to the convening of the regular session
20	of 2008.	
21	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general	
22	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 4 Hawaii, social sciences public policy center, for the purpose of

- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
