A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVERS' LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended b	y adding a new section to part XI to be appropriately			
3	designated and to read as follows:				
4	" <u>§28</u>	6- Commercial drivers under the age of twenty-one.			
5	(a) A pe	rson who is at least eighteen years of age but under			
6	the age of twenty-one shall be permitted to drive a commercial				
7	motor vehicle in the State of Hawaii in intrastate commerce if				
8	the person:				
9	(1)	Is in compliance with Title 49 Code of Federal			
10		Regulations, Part 390 to Part 396, Subpart B, except			
11		section 391.11(b)(1) in the case of an intrastate			
12		driver involved in intrastate commerce in the state;			
13	(2)	Does not transport hazardous materials as defined			
14		under section 286-2;			
15	(3)	Does not transport passengers in a school bus as			
16		defined under section 286-231; and			

1	(4)	Maintair	ns a provisional driver's license or driver's		
2		license for vehicles designated in section 286-			
3		102(b)(3) for the two years immediately preceding			
4		driving commercially under this section; provided that			
5		the person:			
6		<u>(A)</u> Has	s not had the license suspended, revoked, or		
7		car	nceled; or		
8		<u>(B)</u> <u>Has</u>	s not been convicted of:		
9		<u>(i)</u>	Speeding excessively at a rate of fifteen		
10			miles per hour or more above the posted		
11			<pre>speed limit;</pre>		
12		<u>(ii</u>	Driving recklessly, as defined by state or		
13			local law, ordinance, or regulation,		
14			including but not limited to offenses of		
15			driving a motor vehicle in wilful or wanton		
16			disregard for the safety of persons or		
17			property;		
18		<u>(iii)</u>	Making improper or erratic traffic lane		
19			changes;		
20		<u>(iv)</u>	Following a vehicle too closely; or		

1	(v) Violating state or local law relating to
2	motor vehicle traffic control arising in
3	connection with a fatal accident.
4	(b) Notwithstanding the definition in section 286-2, for
5	purposes of this section, "commercial motor vehicle" is limited
6	to vehicles designated in section 286-102(b)(3)."
7	SECTION 2. Section 286-231, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
9	inserted and to read as follows:
10	""Intrastate commerce" means trade, traffic, or
11	transportation between two places in the state, which originates
12	and terminates within the state.
13	"Intrastate driver" means a driver not less than eighteen
14	years of age engaged in intrastate commerce and meeting the
15	requirements under section 286"
16	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2112.
