# H.B. NO.926

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY LAND TRUSTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§201H-</u> Community land trusts; affordable housing; land
5	grants and subsidies. Except where otherwise prohibited, the
6	corporation shall allow community land trusts to be eligible for
7	land grants and state subsidies or funds to be used for the
8	development of affordable housing."
9	SECTION 2. Section 201H-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
11	and to read as follows:
12	"Community land trust" means a private nonprofit
13	organization whose goal is to acquire and hold land for the
14	benefit of the community and provide secure affordable access to
15	land and housing for community residents."
16	SECTION 3. Section 201H-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:



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1 "(e) Moneys available in the fund shall be used for the 2 purpose of providing, in whole or in part, loans or grants for 3 rental housing projects in the following order of priority: 4 (1)Projects or units in projects that are allocated 5 low-income housing credits pursuant to the state housing credit ceiling under section 42(h) of the 6 7 Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or projects 8 or units in projects that are funded by programs of 9 the United States Department of Housing and Urban 10 Development and United States Department of 11 Agriculture Rural Development wherein: 12 (A) At least fifty per cent of the available units 13 are for persons and families with incomes at or 14 below eighty per cent of the median family income of which at least five per cent of the available 15 16 units are for persons and families with incomes 17 at or below thirty per cent of the median family 18 income; and 19 (B) The remaining units are for persons and families 20 with incomes at or below one hundred per cent of

the median family income;

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1		provided that the corporation may establish rules to
2		ensure full occupancy of fund projects; and
3	(2)	Mixed-income rental projects or units in a
4		mixed-income rental project wherein all of the
5		available units are for persons and families with
6		incomes at or below one hundred forty per cent of the
7		median family income [-]; and
8	(3)	Developments by a community land trust, including non-
9		traditional structures such as plantation homes, eco-
10		villages, trailer parks, and developments
11		incorporating indigenous Hawaiian architecture as
12		defined under section 46-1.55; provided that the
13		development qualified for the expedited permitting
14		process under section 201H-38."
