11		contractors, five shall be specialty contractors, and

13		receive any compensation for the member's services,
14		but each shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling
15		expenses incurred in the performance of duties[+]; and
16	(3)	At least three shall be appointed from a list of
17		nominees submitted by the speaker of the house of
18		representatives, and at least three shall be appointed

1	from a list of nominees submitted by the preside	ent of
2	the senate.	
3	(c) Each county shall be represented on the board.	
4	(d) No one, except the three noncontractor members,	shall
5	be eligible for appointment who does not at the time of the	he
6	member's appointment hold a valid and unexpired license to	0
7	operate as a contractor."
