BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§328- Prescription information; confidentiality;
5	penalty. Records relative to prescription information
6	containing individually identifiable patient health information
7	maintained in electronic form or in any other form or medium,
8	shall not be sold or otherwise transferred for consideration by
9	any pharmacy benefits manager, insurance company, or retail,
10	mail order, or internet pharmacy. In addition to other
11	appropriate remedies under this chapter, a violation of this
12	section is an unfair or deceptive act or practice within the
13	meaning of section 480-2. Any right or remedy set forth in
14	section 480-13 may be used to enforce this section."
15	SECTION 2. Section 461-13, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended to read as follows:
