8	conservation leadership and people in understanding conservation
9	issues of statewide significance and focus on solving the
10	highest priority problems; and

12	WHEREAS, Conservation Week will celebrate progress towards
13	the effective management of Hawaii's native ecosystems; and

15	WHEREAS, Conservation Week will have activities that
16	support restoration of rare and endangered species and their
17	habitats; and

20	high-priority management-oriented conservation research and will strengthen the skills of conservation professionals;
