23 24 25	WHEREAS, in many cases, owners of such historic structures may not have the financial means to maintain and preserve these structures and may wish to demolish them; and	
26 27 28 29 30 31	WHEREAS, these structures are probably within the definition of historic properties, as defined in section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, but may not be on the Hawaii register of historic places; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 6E-10, Hawaii Revised 1 Statutes, before initiating any construction, alteration, 2 disposition, or improvement of any nature that will affect a 3 historic property on the Hawaii register of historic places, the 4 landowner must notify the Department of Land and Natural 5 Resources of the proposed action and allow the department to 6 review the effect of the proposed action on the historic 7 8 property; and

10 WHEREAS, standards for review of an application for any 11 construction, alternation, disposition, or improvement that will 12 affect any historic property should include consideration of the 13 historic significance and integrity of the individual building 14 and the overall impact to the historic context; and

16 WHEREAS, the State Historic Preservation Division, 17 Department of Land and Natural Resources, was established to 18 administer a comprehensive historic preservation program and 19 possesses the requisite knowledge, experience, and personnel to 20 review and evaluate the effect of proposed actions on historic 21 properties; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 24 25 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources, State Historic Preservation 26 Division, is requested to work with the Hawaii Historic Places 27 Review Board, county governments, the Historic Hawaii 28 29 Foundation, and other stakeholders to review chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, with respect to whether any changes should be 30 31 made to that law with regard to any proposed action that will affect any historic property, regardless of whether the historic 32 property is on the Hawaii register of historic places, to ensure 33 the intent and public policy expressed in section 6E-1, Hawaii 34 Revised Statutes, is achieved; and 35
