HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU TO STUDY PRE-PAID OR PRE-NEED FUNERAL OR BURIAL PLANS.

WHEREAS, Hawaii's population is aging and it is important 1 to address the needs of elderly consumers; and 2 3 WHEREAS, pre-paid or pre-need plans for funeral or burial 4 contracts are becoming increasingly popular; and 5 6 WHEREAS, generally, under these pre-paid or pre-need 7 funeral or burial plans, consumers pay a funeral service company 8 in installments with the expectation that the money paid will be 9 held in trust, for consumer's benefit, to pay for services upon 10 their death; and 11 12 WHEREAS, consumer advocates have expressed concern about 13 Hawaii's laws governing pre-paid or pre-need funeral or burial 14 15 plans; and 16 WHEREAS, as compared to other states, Hawaii requires a 17 lower percentage of payments made as part of pre-paid or pre-18 need funeral or burial plans to be held in trust, and allows 19 companies to keep a higher percentage of payments before 20 allowing refunds to consumers; and 21 22 WHEREAS, anecdotal evidence suggests that consumers have a 23 difficult time obtaining refunds or changing their pre-paid or 24 pre-need funeral or burial plans; and 25 26 WHEREAS, stronger consumer protection in the area of pre-27 paid or pre-need funeral or burial plans is necessary to 28 safeguard Hawaii's elderly consumers and protect their families; 29 now, therefore, 30 31 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 32 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 33

funeral or burial plans in Hawaii; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Reference 5 Bureau is requested to include in its study: 6 7 A review of other jurisdictions' laws on pre-paid or (1)8 pre-need funeral or burial plans in Hawaii; provided 9 that this review shall include a compilation of an 10 indicative sampling of laws and regulations regarding 11 refunds and trusting of consumers' payments; 12 13 (2) A history of Hawaii's laws and regulations regarding 14 pre-paid or pre-need funeral or burial plans; 15 16 (3) Statistics on pre-paid or pre-need funeral or burial 17 plans in Hawaii; specifically the number of plans that 18 are outstanding, the value of outstanding plans, and 19 any information regarding refunds for outstanding 20 plans; and 21 22 (4) An analysis of consumer complaints made to the 23 Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs or any 24 other entities that receive consumer complaints; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 27 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Acting Director of 28 the Legislative Reference Bureau and the Director of Commerce 29 and Consumer Affairs. 30 31 32 33 OFFERED BY: Mele Canoll 2007-2179 HCR SMA.doc MAR 1 4 2007
