HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL OUTREACH SERVICES TO HOMELESS CHILDREN IN HAWAII.

1 WHEREAS, approximately fifteen per cent of the homeless 2 population in Hawaii are children; and 3 4 WHEREAS, almost one thousand eight hundred children resided 5 in emergency and transitional shelters in Hawaii in 2004-2005; 6 and 7 8 WHEREAS, approximately one thousand children ages five through seventeen enrolled in school in Hawaii in 2006 were 9 10 homeless; and 11 WHEREAS, homeless children are especially vulnerable to 12 13 malnutrition, physical abuse, disease, sexual exploitation, illiteracy, and drug abuse; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, the risks to homeless children become more acute where the child suffers from a disability or has special needs; 17 and 18 19 WHEREAS, homeless children frequently lack access to basic 20 needs and services such as food, clothing, shelter, health care, 21 22 and education; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 25 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 26 Human Services is requested to develop programs to provide 27 medical check-ups for homeless children upon arrival at homeless 28 shelters, schedule educational activities within the shelter for 29 homeless children, and provide shelter employees with training 30 31 to address the special needs of children; and
