HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY AND LABOR AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES COMMITTEE ON LABOR TO CONVENE A JOINT HEARING ON THE LABOR FORCE REQUIREMENTS OF THE PROPOSED TURTLE BAY RESORT EXPANSION AND OTHER POSSIBLE IMPACTS ON THE VIBRANT AND GROWING NORTH SHORE OF OAHU.

WHEREAS, Kuilima Resort Company, based upon a Unilateral 1 Agreement approved in 1986, is now proceeding with plans to 2 expand the Turtle Bay Resort from five hundred to four thousand 3 hotel and condominium units; and 4 5 WHEREAS, such an expansion would require additions to the 6 workforce in order to fill new positions; and 7 8 WHEREAS, the statewide number of employees in accommodation 9 10 and food services was 96,400 in January 2007; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the proposed resort expansion of the Turtle Bay Resort would require an increase of approximately three to four 13 per cent to the statewide workforce of accommodation and food 14 service employees; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the local unemployment rates in the Hauula/Kaaawa 17 regions have been traditionally higher than the statewide 18 unemployment rates; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the number of potential new jobs may have to be 21 filled by residents from other areas of the state in addition to 22 residents of the North Shore; and 23 24 WHEREAS, there exists a substantial shortage of affordable 25 26 housing units throughout Oahu and more particularly on the north shore of Oahu; and 27 28

WHEREAS, the addition of new employees seeking residences 1 2 in the vicinity of the resort would impact housing situation on the north shore; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, new employees who do not live near the resort and would need to commute would add to the increasing traffic 6 problems experienced statewide; now, therefore, 7 8 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 9 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 10 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the Senate 11 Committee on Judiciary and Labor and the House of 12 Representatives Committee on Labor are requested to convene a 13 joint hearing to consider the likely impacts on the labor force 14 by the proposed Turtle Bay Resort expansion; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 17 18 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 19 Representatives, the Chairs of the Senate Committee on Judiciary 20 and Labor and the House of Representatives Committee on Labor, 21 the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, and the Chair of 22 23 the Honolulu City Council. 24 25 26 OFFERED BY:
