HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING HAWAII'S CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO INTRODUCE AND SUPPORT FEDERAL LEGISLATION TO ADDRESS CONCERNS REGARDING THE INSPECTION OF PLANTS AND PRODUCTS FROM FOREIGN COUNTRIES TO PREVENT INVASIVE SPECIES FROM ENTERING THE STATE.

WHEREAS, the threat of invasive species is an on-going 1 concern that requires vigilant inspection and control of 2 unwanted pests at all points of entry into the State; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the federal Plant Protection Act of 2000 preempts 5 any state from regulating foreign commerce to "prevent the 6 introduction or dissemination of a biological control organism, 7 plant pest, or noxious weed"; and 8 9 WHEREAS, consequently the Hawaii Department of Agriculture 10 no longer inspects certain products and produce, including 11 coffee imported from foreign counties that may carry harmful 12 pests into the State; and 13 14 WHEREAS, in 2003, the Department of Homeland Security 15 transferred the United States Department of Agriculture's 16 responsibility for inspecting plant products from foreign 17 countries to the federal Customs and Border Protection agency; 18 19 and 20 WHEREAS, the elimination of the United States Department of 21 Agriculture's inspection authority has left airport passenger 22 and baggage entry ways more vulnerable to penetration by 23 invasive species; and 24 25 WHEREAS, invasive species concerns should be addressed by 26 proactive inspection and regulations for both incoming and 27 outgoing products and produce; and 28 29

WHEREAS, communication and coordination between federal and 1 state inspectors need to be clarified and improved by 2 implementing a concerted federal and state invasive species 3 action plan to provide adequate protection for the State from 4 invasive species; now, therefore, 5 6 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 7 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 8 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that Hawaii's 9 congressional delegation is requested to introduce and support 10 federal legislation concerning the inspection of plants and 11 products from foreign countries including the establishment of a 12 federal and state invasive species action plan, to prevent the 13 introduction of invasive species from entering into the State; 14 and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state Department of 17 Agriculture is requested to work with their federal counterparts 18 to effectuate this Concurrent Resolution; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to members of Hawaii's 22 congressional delegation and the Chairperson of the state Board 23 of Agriculture. 24 25 26 27
