HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO COLLABORATE WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO DEVELOP A TREE CROP INSURANCE PROGRAM FOR TREE FARMS IN HAWAII.

	WHEREAS, tree farming can provide many long-term

2	environmental and economic benefits for the State; and
3	WHEREAS, forests can mitigate the effects of global
4	
5	warming; and
6	WHEREAS, tree farms can protect island watersheds, prevent
7	soil erosion, and provide habitats for wildlife; and
8 9	soll erosion, and provide nabicats for withine, and
9 10	WHEREAS, further development of the tree farm industry in
11	Hawaii can reduce the unfavorable practice of cutting down and
12	destroying native trees from forests statewide for wood because
13	wood produced from tree farms could instead be purchased at the
14	retail markets; and
15	
16	WHEREAS, tree farms are a growing industry in Hawaii that
17	produced \$30,700,000 in revenues in 2001, and has experienced a
18	6.2 per cent increase since 1991; and

20	WHEREAS, expanding the tree farm industry has the potential
21	of increasing lumber processing, creating more furniture-making
22	and other wood carpentry jobs, and promoting an export product,
23	which all can contribute in diversifying and strengthening the
24	State's economy; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, a natural disaster can easily destroy decades of
27	physical work, financial investment, and all its associated
28	economic benefits; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, tree crop insurance can provide economic stability
31	to investors, managers, and employees in the tree farm business,

but private insurance policies for tree crops are not available; 1 2 and 3 WHEREAS, private insurance policies are available, however, 4 for other types of agricultural products, including macadamia 5 nuts, mango trees, tobacco plants, and avocado trees; and 6 7 WHEREAS, private insurance policies for tree crops could 8 become an economically viable option and feasible opportunity if 9 the financial risk could be spread out among the many farms in 10 Hawaii and on the mainland; now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 13 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 14 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 15 Agriculture is requested to collaborate with the United States 16 Department of Agriculture to develop a tree crop insurance 17 program for Hawaii; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Agriculture 20 is requested to submit a written report of its findings and 21 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 22 Legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of 23 the 2008 Regular Session; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 26 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 27 Board of Agriculture; the Secretary of Agriculture, United 28 States Department of Agriculture; Administrator of the United 29 States Department of Agriculture Risk Management Agency; the 30 President of the Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation; and the 31 President of the Hawaii Forest Industry Association. 32 33 34 35 Neme more OFFERED BY: .
