H.C.R. NO. 269

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE OWNERS OF THE TURTLE BAY RESORT TO STOP FURTHER DEVELOPMENT PENDING THE PREPARATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF A SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT TO ITS ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT.

1 WHEREAS, over twenty years ago, in 1986, the City and 2 County of Honolulu issued a special management area for the 3 expansion of what was known at the time as the Kuilima Resort 4 and now called the Turtle Bay Resort on the north shore of Oahu; 5 and

7 WHEREAS, the expansion plans call for the development of up
8 to five additional hotels at the resort, adding thousands of
9 additional units to the rural north shore district; and

WHEREAS, the special management area permit was issued partially based upon an environmental impact statement accepted in 1985, twenty-two years ago; and

15 WHEREAS, while the expansion plans have not been 16 implemented to date, the new owner, Kuilima Resort Company, a 17 subsidiary of Oaktree Capital Management, LLC, of the Turtle Bay 18 Resort is proceeding with plans to commence the expansion plans; 19 and

21 WHEREAS, this passage of time has resulted in significant 22 changes in the environment of the north shore and the expansion 23 now planned could result in impacts that were not considered 24 twenty-two years ago; and

26 WHEREAS, section 11-200-26, Hawaii Administrative Rules 27 (Department of Health), requires that, when the timing of a 28 project significantly changes, the environmental impact 29 statement must be supplemented; and

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 6 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 7 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the present owner 8 of the Turtle Bay Resort, Kuilima Resort Company, is urged to 9 refrain from any further development at the Turtle Bay Resort 10 until a supplemental statement to the original environmental 11 impact statement is prepared, reviewed, and accepted; and 12

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health,
Director of Environmental Quality Control, Chair of the Honolulu
City Council, and Kuilima Resort Company.
