HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO IMMEDIATELY REMOVE THE DERELICT SAILBOAT "DOLPHIN" FROM THE REEF IN THE HAWAIIAN ISLANDS HUMPBACK WHALE NATIONAL MARINE SANCTUARY AREA FACING FRONT STREET, LAHAINA, MAUI.

1 2 3 4 5 6	WHEREAS, the Front Street area of Lahaina between the Lahaina Small Boat Harbor and the Lahaina Center is the visual centerpiece for the historic district of Lahaina town and is featured in numerous television shows, magazine articles, newspapers, and Internet sites worldwide; and
7 8 9 10	WHEREAS, the State has spent millions of taxpayer dollars promoting this area of Lahaina and used it to market Maui as a tourist destination; and
11 12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, in 2003, a recreational sailboat named "Dolphin" ran aground on the inside reef of Lahaina Harbor, in plain view from Front Street, and has remained stranded on the reef creating a permanent blight on this popular, world-renowned view; and
16 17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, the wreckage of the "Dolphin" has given a negative impression on the millions of visitors who visit Lahaina each year and reflects badly on the community and the people of Lahaina, of Maui, as well as of the State of Hawaii; and
22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, the "Dolphin," which remains on the reef today, continues to destroy the fragile reef system and contaminate the nearby marine ecosystem; and
25 26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, the state Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR) has been unable to remove the vessel from the reef due to the complexity involved in, and funds, equipment, and manpower necessary for the removal of the steel hull; and

WHEREAS, the various agencies of the federal government 1 such as the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the 2 United States Coast Guard, and the Department of the Navy, have 3 the necessary manpower, equipment, and resources to remove the 4 wreckage from the reef; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, the wreckage of the "Dolphin" lies within the 8 waters of the federal Hawaiian Islands Humpback Whale National Marine Sanctuary and the environmental damage to the reef and 9 surrounding ecosystem caused by the vessel compromises the 10 integrity of this habitat; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the visual blight caused by the "Dolphin" and the 14 aesthetic damage caused by this derelict vessel is also damaging to the reputation of this important National Marine Sanctuary; 15 16 and 17 18 WHEREAS, the federal government has the authority to provide for the protection of National Marine Sanctuary areas 19 and has conducted various federal operations in this and other 20 21 National Marine Sanctuaries in the past; now, therefore, 22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 23 24 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the federal 25 government is urged to immediately execute operations to remove 26 27 the sailboat "Dolphin" from the reef in the National Marine Sanctuary area facing Front Street, Lahaina, Maui; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 30 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the 31 32 United States, the members of Hawaii's Congressional Delegation, the United States Secretary of Commerce, the Administrator of 33 the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Commandant 34 of the United States Coast Guard, the Secretary of the Navy, and 35 the Chair of the Hawaiian Islands Humpback Whale Sanctuary 36 37 Advisory Council. 38 39 40 OFFERED BY: iren Anana HCR HMS 2007-3100
