18	to enter the United States and certain exigent circumstances
19	should provide visitors with the opportunity to enter the United

24	Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the President of
25	the United States and the United States Congress are
26 27	respectfully urged to establish visa waivers or to relax visa
27 28	requirements for humanitarian reasons, such as serious illness, family emergencies, imminent death, or a funeral for family
29	members, relatives, or close friends; and
