## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

---

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO OPEN AND  
RECONFIGURE THE EASTBOUND SHOULDER LANES FROM MAKAKILO  
DRIVE TO THE WAIPAHU OFF-RAMP ON THE H-1 FREEWAY DURING THE  
MORNING RUSH HOURS TO HELP ALLEVIATE TRAFFIC CONGESTION.

1 WHEREAS, the commute from the Leeward Coast, Ewa Plains,  
2 and communities connected to the H-1 freeway into the downtown  
3 and Waikiki areas lasts more than 90 minutes during the rush  
4 hours; and  
5

6 WHEREAS, the return commute is just as long, if not longer,  
7 during the afternoon rush hours; and  
8

9 WHEREAS, the State and City and County of Honolulu are  
10 exploring and initiating many projects to alleviate the traffic  
11 congestion and long commute times on the H-1 freeway, including  
12 completion of the North-South road, a proposed fixed  
13 rail/guideway system, a Nimitz Highway flyover, and ferry system  
14 from the Leeward Coast to downtown Honolulu; and  
15

16 WHEREAS, each of these ideas have merit, and will help to  
17 combat traffic congestion, but all are future solutions; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, the eastbound and westbound shoulder lanes from  
20 Makakilo Drive to the Kunia Interchange at the eastbound off-  
21 ramp on the H-1 freeway appear to be wide enough to accommodate  
22 another lane of traffic; and

24 WHEREAS, while shoulder lanes are necessary for traffic  
25 safety, traffic congestion is a daily occurrence; and  
26

27 WHEREAS, the use of these shoulder lanes to accommodate  
28 traffic during rush hours may be an immediate and inexpensive  
29 solution to help reduce commute times, which if such times are  
30 reduced, no matter how little the reduction may be, will help



1 the quality of life for residents of the Leeward Coast, Ewa  
2 Plains, and communities served by the H-1 freeway; now,  
3 therefore,  
4

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the  
6 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular  
7 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the Department Of  
8 Transportation is requested to open and reconfigure the  
9 eastbound shoulder lanes from Makakilo Drive to the Waipahu off-  
10 ramp on the H-1 freeway during the morning rush hours to help  
11 alleviate traffic congestion; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of  
15 Transportation and the Governor.
