HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII DO A STUDY TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF DEMOLISHING ALOHA STADIUM AND CONSTRUCTING A NEW STADIUM ON OAHU.

WHEREAS, Aloha Stadium was first opened to the public on 1 September 12, 1975; and 2 3 WHEREAS, while Aloha Stadium has been plagued with 4 structural defects and other problems from its opening day, it 5 has served the people of Hawaii well as a venue for many 6 memorable sporting and entertaining events over its near thirty-7 two year life-span; and 8 9 WHEREAS, a planning study by the local firm of Wiss Janney 10 Elstner Associates, published in December 2005, looked at the 11 long-range prospects for the improvement of Aloha Stadium to 12 continue serving the people of Hawaii into the future; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the Wiss study estimated that the Aloha Stadium 15 would require \$99,000,000 in short-term improvements, including 16 \$29,000,000 for repairs to structural defects and corrosion 17 protection, \$26,000,000 for repairing seating areas, and an 18 additional \$44,000,000 to meet a shortage of three hundred and 19 two toilets in the women's bathrooms, to bring the stadium into 20 compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, and other 21 immediately needed improvements; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the Wiss report went on to state that beyond the 24 initial \$99,000,000, an additional \$115,000,000 in improvements 25 would be needed to extend the useful life of Aloha Stadium for 26 another twenty to thirty years; and 27 28 WHEREAS, a total expenditure of \$214,000,000 will only 29 extend the useful life of the Aloha Stadium twenty to thirty 30 years; and 31



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WHEREAS, it is time to look at a long-term solution for the 2 needs of the people of Hawaii and not continue applying band-3 aids to the problems of an aging stadium at exorbitant costs; 4 5 and 6 WHEREAS, approximately half of the one hundred acres that 7 the Aloha Stadium presently occupies was granted to the City and 8 County of Honolulu by the United States government and, in turn, 9 granted to the State with a condition that the land was to be 10 used for public recreational purposes; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the land beneath Aloha Stadium, due to its 13 location, topography, proximity to public highways, and the 14 availability of infrastructure necessary for development, would 15 be ideal for the development of affordable housing and other 16 mixed-uses; now, therefore, 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 19 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 20 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the President of 21 the University of Hawaii is requested to undertake a preliminary 22 study using, to the extent practicable, personnel and resources 23 at the University of Hawaii, to consider the: 24 25 Demolition of Aloha Stadium; (1)26 27 Redevelopment of the present Aloha Stadium site, 28 (2) through public or public and private partnership 29 efforts, for affordable housing and other mixed-uses, 30 following discussions with the appropriate federal 31 agencies and the City and County of Honolulu on the 32 removal of the condition that the present Aloha 33 Stadium site must be used for public recreational 34 purposes; and 35 36 (3) Development of a new stadium, publicly or privately on 37 a lease-back or turn-key basis, on Oahu, to be 38 operated and managed by the University of Hawaii. 39 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the University 41 of Hawaii is requested to submit to the Legislature, not less 42 than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 43 of 2008, a preliminary report to include the following: 44 HCR LRB 07-2213.doc
