
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

EXTENDING SUPPORT FOR THE PROPOSED MALULANI PRIVATELY DEVELOPED
SECOND HOSPITAL FOR MAUI COUNTY.

1 WHEREAS, the island of Oahu has at least nine major acute
2 care full service hospitals and numerous other medical support
3 facilities; and

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5 WHEREAS, the island of Kauai, with a lesser population base
6 than Maui, has three hospitals; and

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8 WHEREAS, Maui is served by only one acute care full service
9 hospital, Maui Memorial Medical Center; and

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11 WHEREAS, due to the limitations of the Maui Memorial
12 Medical Center, many Maui residents have to be med-evacuated to
13 Oahu for a variety of medical needs, including but not limited
14 to acute cardiac care and neonatal care; and

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16 WHEREAS, a group of doctors and a major private investor
17 proposed the development of a new \$212,000,000, one hundred
18 fifty bed acute care full service Malulani Hospital in Kihei,
19 Maui, including a state-of-the-art cardiac care facility; and

21 WHEREAS, the proposed new hospital has the overwhelming
22 support of the Maui community, including Mayor Alan Arakawa and
23 his administration, along with the full support of Governor
24 Linda Lingle; and

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26 WHEREAS, the State Health Planning and Development Agency
27 denied the proposed hospital a required certificate of need in
28 order to develop the new hospital; and

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30 WHEREAS, the private backers of the proposed Malulani
31 Hospital have filed a request for a reconsideration of the



1 denial of the certificate of need by a reconsideration
 2 committee; now, therefore,

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 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
 5 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
 6 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the State Health
 7 Planning and Development Agency reconsideration committee is
 8 urged to find and establish good cause to overrule the State
 9 Health Planning and Development Agency denial of the certificate
 10 of need required for the development of the proposed Malulani
 11 Hospital; and

 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director
 15 of Health, and Administrator of the State Health Planning and
 16 Development Agency, who is requested to transmit copies to
 17 members of the reconsideration committee.
