HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A COMPARISON STUDY OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AND THE BOARDS OF REGENTS OF SIMILAR STATE UNIVERSITIES ACROSS THE NATION.

1 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii (UH) Board of Regents 2 (BOR) manages and controls the general affairs, and has exclusive jurisdiction over the internal structure, management, 3 4 and operation of UH, and also serves as the State Board for 5 Career and Technical Education; and 6 7 WHEREAS, as part of its powers and as prescribed by sections 304A-105 and 304A-106, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the 8 BOR: 9 10 (1)May purchase or otherwise acquire lands, buildings, 11 12 appliances, and other property for the purposes of UH, and may expend available funds; 13 14 15 (2) Shall manage the inventory, equipment, surplus property, and expenditures of UH, and may adopt rules 16 to do so; 17 18 19 (3) Shall develop internal policies and procedures for the 20 procurement of goods, services, and construction; 21 22 (4)May enter into concession agreements; and 23 (5) May receive, manage, and invest moneys or other 24 property that may be given, bequeathed, devised, or 25 otherwise received from sources other than the 26 Legislature or any federal appropriation for the 27 28 purpose of UH, its improvement or adornment, or the aid or advantage of students or faculty, and in 29 general act as trustee on behalf of UH for these 30 purposes or objects; 31 32 33 and 34

WHEREAS, currently, the BOR is composed of twelve members, 1 including a student member, who are appointed by the Governor 2 and generally serve four-year terms or until their successors 3 have been appointed and have qualified; 4 5 WHEREAS, members of the BOR serve without pay but are 6 7 entitled to expenses for their travel within the state when attending meetings or engaging in business related to the work 8 9 of the BOR; and 10 WHEREAS, other state universities across the nation also 11 have boards of regents that govern the affairs of their 12 respective institutions and carry out their specific duties 13 according to their own sets of rules and procedures to achieve 14 their defined missions; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, it is wise to take a step back from time to time and evaluate one's organization as part of a larger scheme and 18 in comparison with similar organizations, so that one may gain 19 20 an awareness of ways in which their own organization can be improved, especially when the organization is constantly under 21 22 scrutiny by the public eye; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 25 Session of 2007, the Senate concurring, that the University of 26 Hawaii is requested to perform a comparison study on the powers 27 and responsibilities of the Board of Regents of the University 28 of Hawaii in relation to state statutes and the boards of 29 regents of similar state universities across the nation with the 30 intent of enabling the BOR to: 31 32 Delegate those matters that should be delegated; and 33 (1) 34 Retain those matters that meet their fiduciary 35 (2) responsibility for the UH; and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that UH is requested to submit a 38 report of its findings and any recommendations to the 39 Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the 40 Regular Session of 2008; 41 42 43 and 44
