HOUSE RESOLUTION

EXTENDING SUPPORT FOR THE PROPOSED MALULANI PRIVATELY DEVELOPED SECOND HOSPITAL FOR MAUI COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the island of Oahu has at least nine major acute 1 care full service hospitals and numerous other medical support 2 facilities; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the island of Kauai, with a lesser population base 5 than Maui, has three hospitals; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Maui is served by only one acute care full service 8 hospital, Maui Memorial Medical Center; and 9 10 WHEREAS, due to the limitations of the Maui Memorial 11 Medical Center, many Maui residents have to be med-evacuated to 12 Oahu for a variety of medical needs, including but not limited 13 to acute cardiac care and neonatal care; and 14 15 WHEREAS, a group of doctors and a major private investor 16 proposed the development of a new \$212,000,000, one hundred 17 fifty bed acute care full service Malulani Hospital in Kihei, 18 Maui, including a state-of-the-art cardiac care facility; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the proposed new hospital has the overwhelming 21 support of the Maui community, including Mayor Alan Arakawa and 22 his administration, along with the full support of Governor 23 Linda Lingle; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the State Health Planning and Development Agency 26 denied the proposed hospital a required certificate of need in 27 order to develop the new hospital; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the private backers of the proposed Malulani 30 Hospital have filed a request for a reconsideration of the 31 denial of the certificate of need by a reconsideration 32 committee; now, therefore, 33 34



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BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, that the State Health Planning and Development Agency reconsideration committee is urged to find and establish good cause to overrule the State Health Planning and Development Agency denial of the certificate of need required for the development of the proposed Malulani Hospital; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 10 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director of Health, 11 and Administrator of the State Health Planning and Development 12 Agency, who is requested to transmit copies to members of the 13 reconsideration committee.
