HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO COLLECT DATA AND REPORT STATISTICS RELATED TO CASES OF ABUSE OF VULNERABLE ADULTS.

WHEREAS, Hawaii's disabled and elderly adults are some of 1 2 the most vulnerable individuals in the state; and 3 4 WHEREAS, this population is highly susceptible to physical 5 abuse and financial and economic exploitation, recently demonstrated in Hawaii, as cases of fraud and abuse have 6 escalated: and 7 8 WHEREAS, while all of Hawaii's people are prone to physical 9 abuse and financial exploitation, the disabled and elderly are 10 often less able to protect themselves, requiring assistance from 11 12 others; and 13 WHEREAS, the Department of Human Services (DHS), Adult 14 Protective Services (APS), is responsible for receiving and 15 16 investigating reports of abuse on adults who are dependent on another person, organization, or facility because of mental or 17 18 physical impairment; and 19 WHEREAS, the Legislature has considered proposals to expand 20 the scope of APS to include all vulnerable adults, including the 21 elderly; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, APS should also be expanded to include investigations of financial and economic exploitation, a growing 25 concern in society today; and 26 27 WHEREAS, regardless of whether legislation is passed during 28 the Regular Session of 2007, DHS should consider ways that APS 29 can be improved; now, therefore, 30

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 1 2 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2007, that DHS is requested to collect data and 3 report statistics related to cases of abuse of vulnerable 4 5 adults; and 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHS is requested to collect 7 8 data to determine who is being served, who is being turned away, and the reasons why they are being turned away; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the community agencies and 11 mandated reporters are encouraged to report all incidents of 12 abuse of vulnerable adults; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHS is requested to submit a 15 report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no 16 later than 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session 17 of 2008; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 20 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Human Services. 21
