HOUSE RESOLUTION 1 2 3 URGING THE MAJOR COMMERCIAL PRODUCERS OF POI TO PRODUCE POI WITH 4 5 LESS WATER CONTENT. 6 WHEREAS, poi is a staple food of Hawaii made from the corm 7 8 of the taro; and 9 10 WHEREAS, although taro is eaten around the world, only Hawaiians pound taro into poi, a food which has enormous 11 cultural and historical significance for the people of our 12 state; and 13 14 WHEREAS, in addition to its significance as a cultural and 15 16 historical linchpin of traditional Hawaiian society, poi also represents an important part of a healthy diet for Hawaiians and 17 other ethnic groups; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the consistency of poi is measured by the number 20 of fingers it takes to eat the poi; and 21 22 WHEREAS, many consumers of poi prefer "two finger" poi, 23 which implies a dense, thicker serving of poi; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the Legislature has found strong anecdotal 26 evidence from consumers that the consistency of poi sold in bags 27 has become watery over the years, resulting in a dilution of the 28 taste and the health benefits of poi; now, therefore, 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 31 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 32 Session of 2007, that this body urges the major commercial 33 producers of poi to produce poi with less water content; and 34

poi, including the owners of Haleiwa Poi Inc., Hanalei Poi
Company, HPC Foods, Limited, and Pueo Poi Company.
