
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO REQUIRE DEVELOPERS
TO APPEAR BEFORE THE APPROPRIATE NEIGHBORHOOD BOARDS
FOLLOWING CHANGES IN CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT PLANS
PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY THE NEIGHBORHOOD BOARD.

1 WHEREAS, neighborhood boards play a vital role in the
2 planning and permitting process for developments; and
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4 WHEREAS, neighborhood boards review and comment on proposed
5 long range plans and special area planning as well as proposed
6 permit applications; and
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8 WHEREAS, neighborhood boards review and comment on proposed
9 changes to various land development codes, ordinances, and
10 rules; and
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12 WHEREAS, neighborhood boards identify issues and problems
13 that can be addressed through existing or new programs and
14 procedures, and act as a liaison body between the department and
15 the community with respect to land use issues; and
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17 WHEREAS, developers can alter plans for construction or
18 development without new approval from the neighborhood board;
19 now, therefore,
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21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
22 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
23 Session of 2007, that the City and County of Honolulu is
24 requested to require developers to appear before the appropriate
25 neighborhood boards following changes in construction or
26 development plans previously approved by the board; and
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28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
29 Resolution be transmitted to the City Council of Honolulu county
30 and the Mayor of Honolulu.
