(1) Tutoring for specific academic subjects;

(2) Training in study skills, such as time management and note-taking;

(3) Training in test-taking skills; and

 (4) Other services in addition to the homework-assistance services, enrichment activities, and supervised recreational activities currently offered by the A+ Program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DOE is requested to submit the plan to the Legislature at least 20 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2008; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, the Board of Education, and the Superintendent of Education.
