HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF ADULT RESIDENTIAL CARE HOMES.

WHEREAS, an adult residential care home is defined under 1 section 321-15.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as any facility that 2 provides twenty-four hour living accommodations for a fee to 3 adults unrelated to the family, who require at least minimal 4 assistance with the activities of daily living, personal care 5 services, protection, and health care services, but who do not 6 need the professional health services provided in an 7 intermediate, skilled nursing, or acute care facility; and 8 9 WHEREAS, in recent years, there has been a proliferation of 10 the establishment of adult residential care homes on Oahu; and 11 12 WHEREAS, many of the adult residential care homes are 13 located in residential neighborhoods characterized by single 14 family residences, and in commercial or mixed use areas; and 15 16 WHEREAS, concentrations of the adult residential care homes 17 in these areas have attendant traffic, parking, delivery, noise, 18 trash collection, and emergency services response challenges; 19 and 20 21 WHEREAS, the Department of Health is authorized to license 22 the establishment and operation of adult residential care homes; 23 and 24 25 WHEREAS, the Department of Health's authority is apparently 26 superior to that of the City and County of Honolulu's Department 27 of Planning and Permitting to regulate these facilities, 28 including the regulation of the locations of the facilities, 29 their distance from each other, and whether they are compatible 30 with the land use; and 31 32 WHEREAS, there is apparently no regulation to provide an 33 opportunity for public notice, review, or comment, especially by 34 adjoining property owners, regarding pending applications to 35 establish, modify, or expand adult residential care homes; and



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1 2 3 4 5 6 7	WHEREAS, while the City and County of Honolulu has revised each of the development plans and sustainable community plans for Oahu in recent years, the Department of Health has not conducted a similar review or revision of its rules regarding adult residential care homes; and
8	WHEREAS, the Department of Health should conduct a study of
9	residential care home facilities; now, therefore,
10 11	BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
12	Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
13	Session of 2007, that the Department of Health is requested to
14	conduct a study of residential care home facilities; and

16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in completing the study, the
17 18	Department of Health is requested to:
18	(1) Examine and determine the adequacy of the statutes,
20	administrative rules, and inspection and enforcement
21	processes, related to the establishment, modification,
22	and expansion of adult residential care facilities;
23 24	(2) Determine whether adequate opportunity exists for
24 25	public notice and participation in the inspection and
26	enforcement processes related to the establishment,
27	modification, and expansion of adult residential care
28	facilities; and

30	(3) Consult with the Attorney General and the Director of the Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting;

34	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is
35	requested to submit a report to this body no later than twenty
36	days prior to the convening of the 2008 Regular Session; and

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Attorney General, and the Director of the Honolulu Department of 1 2 Planning and Permitting.
