
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COLLABORATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM, TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO EVALUATE PLANS BY YOUNG BROTHERS, LTD., TO DISCONTINUE ITS LESS-THAN-CONTAINER-LOAD INTERISLAND CARGO SERVICE.

1 WHEREAS, interisland cargo service is a vital lifeline for
2 the islands of Hawaii, particularly the Neighbor Islands; and
3

4 WHEREAS, Young Brothers, Ltd. (Young Brothers), runs the
5 state's largest interisland cargo shipping service; and
6

7 WHEREAS, Young Brothers has announced its intention to
8 discontinue its less-than-container-load interisland cargo
9 service; and
10

11 WHEREAS, current customers of Young Brothers, especially
12 farmers on the Neighbor Islands, have expressed grave concerns
13 about Young Brothers' plans; and
14

15 WHEREAS, reliable, affordable, convenient interisland cargo
16 service is essential to the economy of the state and the welfare
17 of its people; now, therefore,
18

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
20 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
21 Session of 2007, that the Department of Transportation (DOT), in
22 collaboration with the Department of Business, Economic
23 Development, and Tourism, is requested to conduct a study to
24 evaluate plans by Young Brothers, Ltd. (Young Brothers), to
25 discontinue its less-than-container-load interisland cargo
26 service:
27

28 (1) For Kahului, Maui, and Hilo, Hawaii, after January 1,
29 2010; and
30

31 (2) For Kona, Hawaii; Honolulu; Molokai; Lanai; and Lihue,
32 Kauai, after January 1, 2012;

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study:

- 5 (1) Identify the potential consequences of the proposed
6 discontinuation of less-than-container-load cargo
7 service for local business, including the possibility
8 of higher shipping costs and delayed shipments;
9
- 10 (2) Investigate the reasons cited by Young Brothers for
11 discontinuing less-than-container-load cargo service,
12 including the apparent shortage of harbor dock space;
13
- 14 (3) Evaluate the impact of the forthcoming Hawaii
15 Superferry service on the ability of Young Brothers to
16 maintain its less-than-container-load cargo service;
17
- 18 (4) Provide descriptions and updates of any efforts to
19 maintain Young Brothers' current operation of less-
20 than-container-load cargo service, including any
21 additional space provided or improvements made at
22 harbors to accommodate this service;
23
- 24 (5) Recommend solutions or alternatives to address the
25 discontinuation of Young Brothers' less-than-
26 container-load cargo service, such as the use of
27 freight consolidators and changes to harbor
28 infrastructure, and provide estimates of the cost
29 effect of the recommended solutions and alternatives;

- 32 (6) Consider any other matter necessary to fully evaluate
33 and develop solutions to Young Brothers' plans to
34 discontinue its less-than-container-load interisland
35 cargo service;

39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DOT submit its findings and
40 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
41 Legislature at least 20 days prior to the convening of the
42 Regular Session of 2008; and
