HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO PLAN SUFFICIENT ON-CAMPUS PARKING AT KAPIOLANI COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

1 WHEREAS, Kapiolani Community College (KCC), located on the slopes of Diamond Head, presently has an enrollment of 7,300 2 students who commute daily to this campus; and 3 4 WHEREAS, there are 225 parking spaces for 550 staff members 5 6 and 942 stalls for students on campus, a ratio of one stall per six users which is the largest shortfall of parking in the UH 7 system; and 8 9 WHEREAS, in 2005, Dr. John Morton, then KCC Chancellor, 10 11 estimated that there was a need for 400 additional parking spaces during peak class periods; and 12 13 WHEREAS, a 2005 student study found that many students 14 arrive on campus early in the morning, hours ahead of their 15 scheduled classes, in order to secure a parking space, then 16 study or sleep until class time; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, when all campus stalls are taken, students must then park in the Kaimuki neighborhood, an old community with 20 narrow streets with little room for parking; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, many Kaimuki homes have garages for only one car, so residents must also park on the streets; and 24 25 WHEREAS, future growth of Kapiolani Community College will 26 entail growth in the size of the student body, a corresponding 27 increase in the number of instructors, administrative and 28 29 maintenance staff and the construction of additional offices and classrooms; and 30 31

1 WHEREAS, commensurate with this growth will be a demand for 2 more parking stalls, so it would behoove the University of 3 Hawaii leadership, when drawing up a master plan, to include 4 additional parking at KCC, either by constructing a parking 5 structure, or designing parking adjacent to or under future 6 buildings in order to alleviate parking and traffic congestion 7 on campus and in the surrounding community; now, therefore, 8

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 10 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 11 Session of 2007, that this body requests the University of 12 Hawaii system to plan for additional parking at Kapiolani 13 Community College, either through a parking structure, or 14 parking adjacent or under future buildings to alleviate crowding 15 on campus and in the adjacent neighborhood; and 16

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 18 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the University of 19 Hawaii, the Chancellor of the University of Hawaii Community 20 Colleges, Dr. Leon Richards, the Interim Chancellor to Kapiolani 21 Community College, Councilmember Charles Djou, and the Chair of 22 the Kaimuki Neighborhood Board No. 4.
