## HOUSE RESOLUTION

RESPECTFULLY CALLING UPON THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO REQUEST BY RESOLUTION THAT THE UNITED NATIONS OFFICE FOR OUTER SPACE AFFAIRS PROACTIVELY ADVANCE THE CAUSE OF WORLD PEACE AND COOPERATION BETWEEN NATIONS.

1 WHEREAS, the United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs 2 (UNOOSA) is the United Nations office principally responsible 3 for promoting international cooperation in the peaceful uses of 4 outer space; and

6 WHEREAS, Planet Earth is much like an island in a great and 7 fathomless ocean, separated from other planets and celestial 8 bodies by thousands, millions, billions, and in some instances 9 trillions of miles; and

WHEREAS, astronauts, cosmonauts, and numerous other brave 11 souls who have ventured into outer space during the last 47 12 years have marveled at how special, unique, and wonderful our 13 Planet Earth is from space, including NASA astronaut Roger 14 Chaffee who remarked, "The world itself looks cleaner and so 15 much more beautiful. Maybe we can make it that way - the way 16 God intended it to be - by giving everyone, eventually, that new 17 perspective from out in space"; and 18 19

WHEREAS, on September 21, 1987, before the United Nations General Assembly, President Ronald Reagan remarked, "In our obsession with antagonisms of the moment we often forget how much unites all the members of humanity"; and

WHEREAS, when one considers the vastness of space and the relatively small size of our Planet in comparison to the scale of the Universe, even our most massive conflicts and violent political disputes among nations seem minor; and

30 WHEREAS, we as a human race have much to learn, not only 31 from one another, but from exploration of the planets, stars, 32 and solar systems beyond our own; and

1 statistically speaking, there are four hundred 2 WHEREAS, billion stars just in our galaxy alone, and if only one in a 3 million of those had planets, and if just one of a million of 4 those had life, and if just one out of a million of those had 5 intelligent life, there would be literally millions of 6 civilizations out there, making our conflicts with our fellow 7 man seem irrelevant and petty in the grand scheme of things; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the expansion of knowledge and the humility from 10 discovering new worlds and unlocking secrets of the stars could 11 greatly impact the progress of mankind, possibly leading to 12 decreased violence against one's own kind and even an end to 13 14 warfare and strife altogether; and 15 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives is deeply concerned 16 about the future of our keiki, our ohana, and our Planet; now, 17 18 therefore, 19 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 20 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 21 Session of 2007, that in the name of connecting humanity, 22 23 bridging divides of conflict and bringing about peace, that this body respectfully calls upon the United Nations General Assembly 24 25 to request by resolution that the UNOOSA proactively advance the 26 cause of world peace and cooperation between nations through 27 space exploration; and 28 IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the United Nations General 29 ΒE Assembly is also humbly requested to include its resolution to 30 the UNOOSA a call to unite the nations in not only the pursuit 31 of new peaceful uses of space, but also a search for intelligent 32 life and a definitive answer to whether or not it has come to 33 Earth or is in our reach; and 34 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to: 37 38 The President of the UN General Assembly; 39 (1)The President of the United States; 40 (2) (3) The Vice President of the United States; 41
