HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE HAWAIIAN ELECTRIC COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO THE POWER OUTAGE RESULTING FROM THE OCTOBER 15, 2006, EARTHQUAKES.

WHEREAS, during the early morning on October 15, 2006, two 1 large earthquakes occurred within minutes of each other off the 2 coast of the island of Hawai'i; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the earthquakes' effects were felt across the 5 State, including the island of Oahu; and 6 7 WHEREAS, minutes after the second earthquake ended, an 8 electrical power outage occurred across the entire island of 9 Oahu; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the Hawaiian Electric Company's (HECO) response in 12 restoring power seemed unreasonably slow, and hundreds of 13 thousands of HECO's customers were left without power for up to 14 a day following the earthquake; and 15 16 WHEREAS, residents on Oahu and customers of Hawaiian 17 Electric Company are understandably concerned about the causes 18 of the power outage, the lengthy duration of the power outage, 19 20 and efforts that can be taken to prevent future power outages of this scope and magnitude; now, therefore, 21 22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 23 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 24 Session of 2007, that the Public Utilities Commission is 25 requested to conduct an investigation of the management, 26 procedures, and practices of the Hawaiian Electric Company with 27 28 regard to its response to the October 15, 2006, earthquakes and resulting power outage; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Utilities Commission 31 is requested to include in its investigation an examination of 32 the timeliness and appropriateness of HECO's response and 33

34 measures to be taken to improve response in the future; and
