
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE
KAILUA RESERVOIR TO THE WAIMANALO RESERVOIR.

1 WHEREAS, the town of Waimanalo is located in the city and
2 county of Honolulu in the district of Koolaula on the eastern
3 end of the island of Oahu; and
4

5 WHEREAS, in 2000 the United States Census Bureau identified
6 a total population of 10,963 persons living in the Waimanalo,
7 Waimanalo beach, and Waimanalo home land areas; and
8

9 WHEREAS, other city, state, and federal agencies and
10 community organizations recognize Waimanalo as distinct and
11 separate from the geographic entity known as Kailua; and
12

13 WHEREAS, the Kailua reservoir, built in the 1930s, is
14 located in what is currently known as Waimanalo, not Kailua; and
15

16 WHEREAS, the Kailua reservoir is approximately four hundred
17 feet southwest of the intersection of Waikupanaha and Kumuahu
18 streets, which are located in Waimanalo; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
22 Session of 2007, that this body requests the Board of
23 Agriculture to change the name of the Kailua reservoir to the
24 Waimanalo reservoir to promote accuracy in place names and
25 encourage precise designations; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
28 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of
29 Agriculture and the Governor of the State of Hawaii.
