HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A FINANCIAL AND MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE MAYOR WRIGHT HOMES TENANT ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, Mayor Wright Homes (often referred to as "Mayor 1 Wright Housing") was the first post-World War II project by the 2 Hawaii Housing Authority, and was dedicated in 1953 and later 3 4 named after the late Mayor of Honolulu, George F. Wright, in 5 1958; and 6 WHEREAS, facilities in Mayor Wright Homes have continuously 7 8 suffered from maintenance problems, property damage, broken windows, sewage problems, trash problems, and other physical 9 10 upkeep problems; and 11 WHEREAS, Mayor Wright Homes has also had a turbulent 12 history of hope and despair marked by social problems, crime, 13 outsider intervention, internal strength, shootings, and other 14 violence; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the Mayor Wright Homes Tenant Association (MWHTA) 17 was formed to improve relations between residents and public 18 19 housing management; and 20 WHEREAS, the members of MWHTA are elected from and by the 21 residents; and 22 23 WHEREAS, MWHTA has a treasury of funds but no audit trail; 24 25 and 26 WHEREAS, the MWHTA election for the 2006-2009 term 27 generated significant protests from residents due to alleged 28 irregular procedures and improper uses of election funds; and 29 WHEREAS, there are allegations of leniency toward relatives 30 of MWHTA members who violate rules or otherwise disrupt the 31 peace; and 32 33

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WHEREAS, residents of Mayor Wright Homes have observed that 1 Citizen Patrol timesheets do not match residents' observations 2 of the times that patrollers spend walking their beats; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, residents of Mayor Wright Homes have videotaped so many pet leash and cleanup violations that the Pet Committee has 6 dissolved itself; and 7 8 WHEREAS, there are allegations of discrimination against 9 Micronesians that need to be addressed; and 10 11 WHEREAS, recent Hawaii Public Housing Authority Annual 12 Plans do not address the viability and appropriateness of tenant 13 association operations or finances; now, therefore, 14 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 17 Session of 2007, that the Auditor is requested to conduct a 18 financial and management audit of MWHTA; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 21 report any findings and recommendations to the Legislature no 22 later than 20 days before the convening of the Regular Session 23 of 2008; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 26 Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, Director of Business, 27 Economic Development, and Tourism, and Executive Director of the 28

29 Hawaii Public Housing Authority.

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
