A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WAIMANO RIDGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that good communication SECTION 1. 2 and relations between the state administration and the residents of the Waimano ridge community are imperative in planning the 3 use of the state-owned lands in the Waimano ridge area. 4 5 The legislature further finds that a new or updated master plan for the state-owned Waimano ridge lands is 6 necessary. In the early 1990s, there was a collaborative 7 government and community effort to establish a master plan for 8 the Waimano ridge area. This master plan was formulated by the 9
- department of health with community input and was designed to 10
- create a "totally integrated community" where activities on the 11
- state-owned Waimano ridge lands would be community-friendly. 12
- However, after the plan was developed, the State's economy took 13
- a downturn and the in-patient care facility on the Waimano ridge 14
- closed, which significantly affected the implementation of the 15
- 16 master plan.

- 1 In 2005, the legislature enacted Act 7, Special Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2005, which required the department of health to
- 3 give prior notice to the Waimano neighborhood board and the
- 4 members of the legislature from that district and to obtain the
- 5 approval of the governor for any use of state-owned land under
- $oldsymbol{6}$ the department's jurisdiction in the Waimano ridge area prior to
- 7 use of the land. Additionally, Act 7 required the department to
- 8 prepare an updated master plan for the Waimano ridge lands.
- 9 In 2006, the legislature and the department of health
- 10 convened the Waimano ridge task force to improve communications
- 11 and relations between the community and the State and to lay the
- 12 groundwork for a new master plan.
- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to
- 14 facilitate the establishment of a "totally integrated community"
- 15 where activities on the state-owned Waimano ridge lands will be
- 16 community-friendly by funding the activities of the Waimano
- 17 ridge task force and establishing a comprehensive Waimano ridge
- 18 master plan.
- 19 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000 or so much
- 21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 and the

- 1 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 2 2008-2009 for the Waimano ridge task force operating expenses.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of health for the purposes of this section.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
