A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIFORM INFORMATION PRACTICES ACT (MODIFIED).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 92F-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Any other provision in this chapter to the contrary
- 4 notwithstanding, each agency shall make available for public
- 5 inspection and duplication during regular business hours: .
- 6 (1) Rules of procedure, substantive rules of general
- 7 applicability, statements of general policy, and
- 8 interpretations of general applicability adopted by
- 9 the agency;
- 10 (2) Final opinions, including concurring and dissenting
- opinions, as well as orders made in the adjudication
- of casés, except to the extent protected by section
- 13 92F-13(1);
- 14 (3) Government purchasing information, including all bid
- results, except to the extent prohibited by section
- 16 92F-13;

20		(C) The objectives of the contract,

22		shall not be disclosed and home addresses.

- (12) Water service consumption data maintained by the boards of water supply;
- (13) Rosters of persons holding licenses or permits granted by an agency that may include name, business address, type of license held, and status of the license;
- The name, compensation (but only the salary range for 8 (14)employees covered by or included in chapter 76, and 9 sections 302A-602 to 302A-640, and 302A-701, or 10 bargaining unit (8)), job title, business address, 11 business telephone number, job description, education 12 and training background, previous work experience, 13 dates of first and last employment, position number, 14 type of appointment, service computation date, 15 occupational group or class code, bargaining unit 16 code, employing agency name and code, department, 17 division, branch, office, section, unit, and island of 18 employment, of present or former officers or employees 19 of the agency; provided that this paragraph shall not 20 require the creation of a roster of employees; and 21 provided further that this paragraph shall not apply 22

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1		to information regarding present or former employees
2		involved in an undercover capacity in a law
3		enforcement agency;
4	(15)	Information collected and maintained for the purpose of
5		making information available to the general public;
6		and
7	(16)	Information contained in or compiled from a transcript,
8		minutes, report, or summary of a proceeding open to
